### **SEL Employee Owners Share Experiences With Illinois Congressman**

PULLMAN, WA — June 5, 2014 — Schweitzer Engineering Laboratories, Inc. (SEL) employee owners shared their perspectives on company ownership with Congressman Peter Roskam (R-IL) on Monday when he visited the company's Fault Indicator and Sensor Division in Lake Zurich, Illinois.
